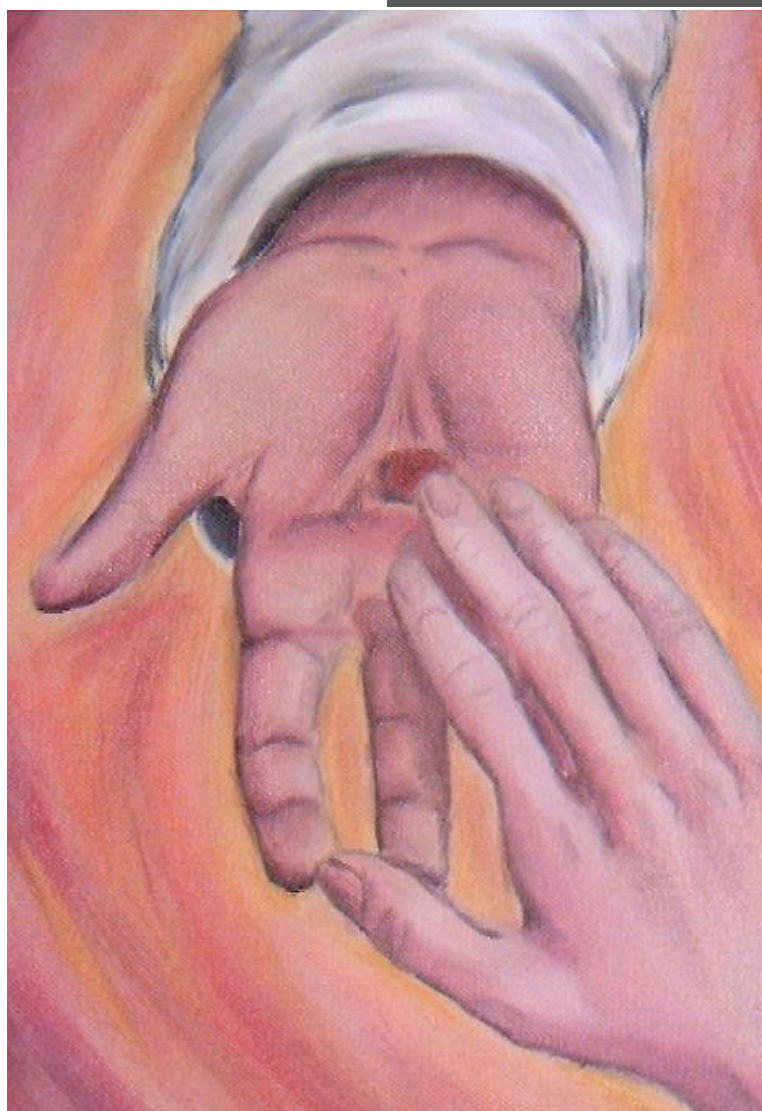

PRIEST'S PRATTLE

RESURRECTION JOY

One Christian greeted another, "Hi. How are you going?"

"Ahh, not bad, under the circumstances," replied the other.

"What are you doing under there?" said his friend.

While not a recommended response to someone in trouble, we hear the point the story is making: No matter what the circumstances, the risen, present Christ empowers us with grace to meet and deal with them, i.e. to know peace and joy in the midst of trouble. Christian friends are called to be channels of that peace/grace.

What a difference it makes to know that in Christ the victory is assured. He said, *"In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."* And his resurrection proves his claim.

Further we have seen that claim borne out in the history of God's people in innumerable examples of his faithfulness as people have confronted and overcome all manner of personal afflictions, as well as in people who have given themselves - often at great cost or risk - to help others so afflicted. (Read about Maximilian Kolbe, Martin Luther King, Dietrich Bonhoeffer). *"Be of good cheer (rejoice), I have overcome the world."*

Delight yourselves in the Lord, yes, find your joy in him at all times. Have a reputation for gentleness, and never forget the nearness of your Lord.

Don't worry over anything whatever; tell God every detail of your needs in earnest and thankful prayer, and the peace of God which transcends human understanding, will keep constant guard over your hearts and minds as they rest in Christ Jesus.
