PRIEST'S PRATTLE

Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead,
and Christ shall give you light. Eph 5.14

Have you ever witnessed resurrection? You probably have but, like me, failed to recognise what you were seeing.

I was immensely privileged about 35 years ago to have my eyes forcefully opened. Invited to participate in a weekend-long group workshop, I was very much an observer. The participants came from a district nursing service. One was M. Through Saturday and part of Sunday, M looked like a person carrying a heavy burden. She gave the impression of a frump: She walked with eyes almost downcast, shoulders slumped and, while attentive to what was going on, barely opened her mouth.

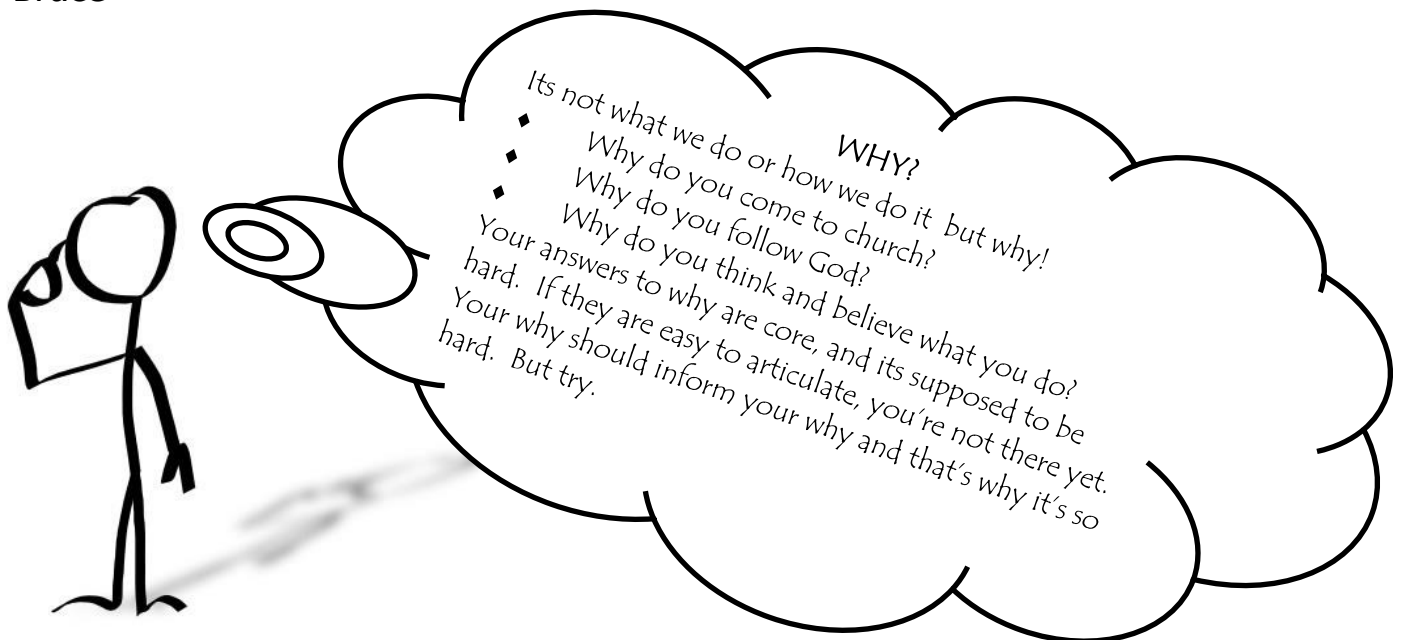
Then, in response to an involuntary action of M's, the facilitator, K, gently asked what was going on. Through his undivided attention, patient listening and response, she revealed a self-belief, born of experience of abuse within her family of origin and her married life, that she was only worth what she 'produced'. She had not been loved for herself, so had no sense of worth in herself. She had become a doormat. The real M was dead, effectively buried under the weight of her self-negating belief.

K asked what she was going to do about it. Her immediate response was one of powerlessness but, through his words and actions and total belief in her, she literally threw off that crushing burden. When she walked out at the end of the weekend M had the stature of a queen. There was resurrection: Life from the dead.

Resurrections - others' and our own - are all about if we have eyes to see them. Christ invites us further: Awake, O sleeper, and rise from the dead, and Christ will give you light.
