## PRIEST'S PRATTLE

From my reading: The following is an extract from J V Taylor's profound book on Holy Spirit, The Go-Between God. It is worth reading and rereading - with praise. As we continue through this season of resurrection, it helps us enter the fulness of God's eternal purpose.

### THE CO-INHERENCE OF LOVE

The mystery that is God,  
the ocean in which all things are sustained  
and from which they receive their being,  
the unimaginable Beyond which makes people aware of itself  
in sudden glimpses of another dimension of glory and meaning  
in ordinary phenomena and events,  
this sea of joy, which is, within itself,  
the timeless exchange of love given and received,  
this self-renouncing Christ-like power,  
in the weakness of self-chosen limitation,  
is set upon the venture of opening out that love  
into a relationship with what is not God but a true Other,  
raised up within God  
to be the object and heir of that love and joy,  
returning love for love and sharing the eternal bliss.
