## VICAR'S VOICE

This week we have Mark's version of Jesus saying, we might think, callously; who is my mother, who are my brothers or sisters? Those who do my will and the will of my Father, is my brother and sister and mother.

As a family woman and in particular a mother, I struggle with the immediate thoughts and feelings which arise from this reading. I wonder if I can cope with my God saying to me, that God must come first, above and beyond my duties as mother, sister, wife and our family's matriarch. I wonder, did Jesus mean to be harsh. I wonder did his mother and his family understand the bluntness of his actions and words. I wonder does God ask us to choose one over another, like a jealous parent, or as an arbitrary thought?

For what it's worth, I don't think any of these things, although they are often still my first emotional response to this reading. The mother in me, initially baulks at the idea that I could be rejected by my beloved children for God, or for anything else. But then I remember who my God is and how my God interacts with his/her children. Jesus says to us, whatever you ask in my name, God will give. Whenever you seek God's face, you will be rewarded. When you knock, the door will be opened and not only opened, but the kingdom of heaven will be laid open for you and only you, and all of you. My God loves me fiercely, even more than I love my children, which is also almost inconceivable to me, or indeed any parent who loves their children with all their heart. But there you have the truth of it. God, in all God's complexity of Triune; Trinity (3 in 1), wants, no demands to be in relationship with you. And God loves you with all the passion and drive that you love, and then some, and then double it, and you have barely a glimpse of the magnitude of love, that your God has for you.

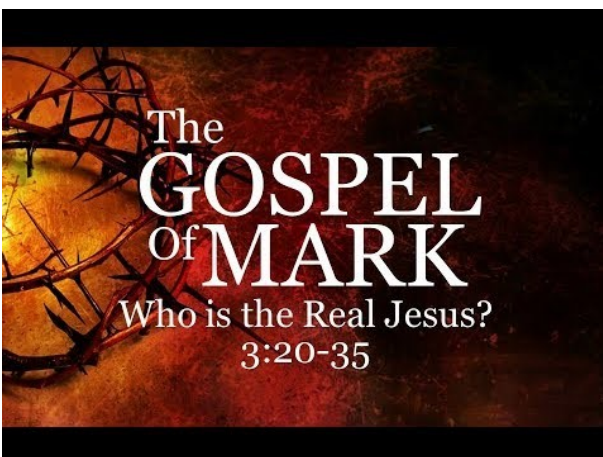
Why do you think you love in the first place? Because all love comes from God and returns to God. No, not a choice, but a truth and a revelation.
