PRIEST'S PRATTLE

Proverbs 29:18, *'Where there is no vision, the people perish'.*

Last Saturday the parish, or rather 25 people from the parish had a fabulous visioning day. I know many of you were not there, but I wish you had been. I know many of you believe a few things about days like this. Like: we've done it before, we've seen it before, we heard it all before. But that is not true. You've never been a part of this particular group, on this particular day, talking, dreaming and loving passionately about St Peter's and our core 'purpose'. And I wish you had been.

We explored our 'why'; our purpose. Why are we here. Why we love God. Why we come to worship, or identify with each other here? The discussion was rigorous and energetic. We talked about our purpose for being, our core belief system, why we do what we do, and why we think and believe what we do. I was and 'am' inspired and overwhelmed and excited, about how we can and will, move and change and have our beings in this place, through this kind of 'why' thinking. How we will realise our 'why'.

So, what do I want? I believe that we should come together and talk about and dream about, our 'why' together, in specific groups and settings, but I also believe, that there is already some energy for this and that it won't simply be more to do.

Why am I telling you all this. Well, because we need 'you'. You, are St Peter's. I am not St Peter's on my own. We, collectively are St Peter's; are the church of God in this place. We believe at our core, that salvation and redemption come from the God of sacrifice and love, and who is personified in Jesus Christ. We believe this same God is living, breathing, enacting here in Wynnum, in our worship, our purpose, our community of people here. We are the body of Christ here. We are the family of God here. We, not me, or someone else, is tasked and empowered to work for the body in this place. We! Not some fly by nighter from the diocese, not even some good speaker from East Redland's, 'us'. We are the only people uniquely qualified to answer questions and right wrongs and come together in Christ's name here in Wynnum, for St Peter's.

So what do I really want?

Truth!

You! Not just those of you who were at the visioning day, but those who weren't. Those of you who can catch a glimpse of the vision also.

We need 4-6 people for the Mission Action Planning (MAP) Team. Those who can see some of the big picture and those who can see outside the box. Don't be shy, I know many of you are good, even great at this.

We need people to think about stuff for us. Think and talk to others in a small group about Worship; Mission; Discipleship; Fellowship; Ministry.
Think Tank's!

But, more importantly, what do you want? What do you think? What do you believe? These are not rhetorical statements or questions. These are not rhetorical thoughts or processes. This is our parish, our church, our body of Christ, our family.

I love you guys as my family and I want us to grow and reach our potential. I will love you anyway, but my love for you and for God causes me to want more, and to realise more, than we are at this precise moment. With the power of Christ and the love of God in our hearts, we have the wherewithal to be able to achieve something great here at St Peter's. Will you join in and offer yourself to the process with love and energy.

Have a great week, and talk to me, or the wardens, or anyone else who potentially shares our vision.
