## PRIEST'S PRATTLE

Can you imagine how you would react if it was you that saw and experienced what those seeing the disciples saw at Pentecost? What would you do, if you headed down to the foreshore and saw the same spectacle that was that first Pentecost? On first inspection, the people you have come to see, look like ordinary people in ordinary clothing. There's just one little difference in this ordinariness. These folk have real life flickering tongues of fire hanging over their heads. And what's more, these same people are speaking in English, except that the Chinese hear Chinese and not English, the Arabs hear Arabic, the Kiwi's hear Maori and the Vietnamese and Sudanese hear their respective language. Somehow even though your brain tells you it's impossible, you believe what you are seeing and hearing. As you look around at everyone else there, you realise you're all caught in the same illusion, or delusion. Surely it must be an illusion, it can't be anything else can it? Still, it doesn't take long to realise that these strangers with their fire tongues on their heads are speaking directly into your heart and what's more your heart knows beyond a shadow of a doubt, what they say is true.

Now let me ask you, have you ever had a disconnect with what you know in your heart to be true and what you think must be the truth. Your heart tells you one thing and you want to believe, but your head tells you it's nonsense or fanciful or illusion. And, do you just go with your brain, because that's what society tells you, you should do. Conform, be like everyone else. Don't rock the boat, or speak out of turn. Imagine what your family and friends would say if you came home from the foreshore with this story and no pictures. They would call you naive, gullible, maybe infantile, or delusional, to believe in a God you can't see, touch, taste or feel. Maybe, they've got a point, the world does seem to be going to hell in a hand basket. Maybe, you even ask yourself how could God let this stuff happen. Somehow it must all be God's fault. Then have you ever had to marry these opposing positions? Do you feel defensive? Do you dismiss your own hearts truth, for what others tell you or what your head states must be true.

Can you see the correlation with what happened at Pentecost for the disciples and the crowd, with these questions above? I would suggest that Jesus always, always, always speaks to the truth in your heart and not to the logic in your brain. If you try hard enough you can pull any argument to its knees about who God is and how Christ redeemed us through his death and resurrection. But the simple truth is, the Holy Spirit of the living triune God will always, always speak truth, directly to your heart.

Will you listen?
